Valley of the Sun United Way and Jobs for Arizona's Graduates are committed to preparing youth to succeed in middle school, high school and on the path to graduation.

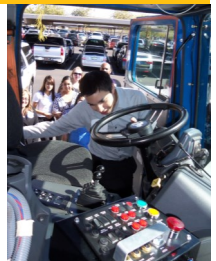


Arizona Cardinals participate in a mural project at Balsz Elementary and Coronado High School Students explore healthcare careers at Scottsdale Healthcare.
